### Local Trainings

The consortium partners from Czech Republic, France, Germany, Slovenia and Poland developed the educational programme for the new 5-day training on Intergenerational Cooperation including a specially designed set of worksheets and supported by the online Activity Register with a range of activities in the five areas of Art and Crafts, Communication, Culture and History, Movement and Outdoor.

In order to further multiply this course, representatives of each partner country attended the 5-day training in Prague (TtT) in February 2019. These future trainers have thus been equipped with necessary skills to implement the shorter one-day programme in local environments of the partner countries. In spring 2019 these local trainings were conducted in each of the project countries. The evaluation results show a high satisfaction of the trainees with the contents as well as with the teaching methods of the Intergenerational Cooperation Training.

### Fifth Project Meeting

On June 3-4, 2019 the project partners met in Prague for their fifth project meeting in order to plan and organize the final steps in the project development as well as to sum up the results and outcomes gained so far.

The last months of the project lifetime will be mainly dedicated to the adaption of the outcomes to national requirements, in particular the activity register with more than 100 activities. This approach will ensure the appropriateness of the resources for an easy use in different European countries and support sustainability of project outcomes for the future work in Intergenerational Cooperation.

Another main focus will be the enhanced activities of project partners on disseminating and multiplying the project outcomes on national and European level. The Final Conference in Prague (Czech Republic) that kicked-off these activities will be followed by Multiplier Events taking place in all project countries during the months to come.

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## Final Conference in Prague

More than 100 participants from Czech Republic, Hungary, France, Slovakia, Germany, Slovenia and Poland attended the First International Intergenerational Conference in Prague on June 3, 2019..

Four key speakers highlighted different aspects of the topic: Prof. Dr. Irmgard Schroll-Decker, University of Regensburg (Germany): Intergenerational education and learning; Juan Daniel Goncalves, D-TAG (Hungary): Influence of social media on intergeneration relationship; Anna Turska, Froebel.pl (Poland): Educational innovation based on the pedagogical concept of Friedrich Froebel and Ivo Rašín, SLUŽBY A ŠKOLENÍ MB, z. ú. (Czech Republic): Benefits and impacts of intergenerational activities on seniors and children.

Moreover, the project and its intellectual outputs, mainly the newly developed activity register, were introduced by the coordinator. The project partners presented best practices concerning intergenerational cooperation from each of the project countries.
